Preposiciones acentuadas en castellano Marcela Depiante University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire

In this talk I will present new data from contemporary Argentinean Spanish showing instances where certain prepositions appear obligatorily stressed when their complements are not overtly present but unstressed when the complements are overtly present. I will show how these data constitute evidence in favor of Hualde's (2009) proposal that all function words in Spanish are underlyingly stressed as well as evidence for his destressing rule on function words in Spanish.
