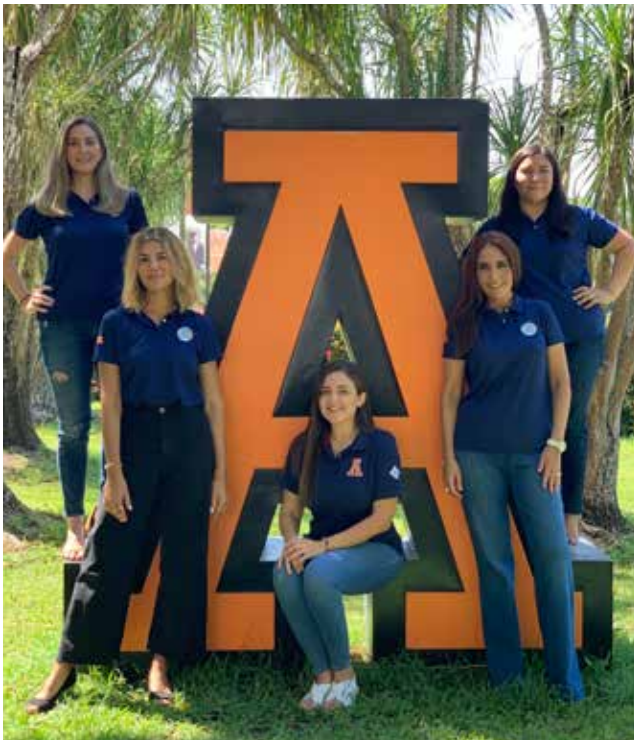

Language proficiency	<p>For exchange students we require a B1 level of Spanish in order to be able to follow the lectures. Students need to present a Certificate B1 or a document issued by the University Language department of the home institution.</p> <p>Courses in English: Certificate B2 or a document issued by the University Language department of the home institution.</p>
