Being a scientific and cultural center of the Western region of Lithuania, Klaipeda University also attracts people for language studies. Lithuanian language courses are being held more than 20 years and got a worldwide recognition from Europe to America, from Australia to China and Japan. Our *alumni* cherish friendly relations. Some *alumni* come again and again to learn/improve Lithuanian language each time at a more advanced level, initiate collaboration projects, and become our friends, colleagues.

Among numerous participants from foreign universities, we always have persons of Lithuanian origin.

Briefly, our summer academy offers:

- *Intensive language teaching program*: 4 classroom hours from Monday to Friday + language practice, consultations.
- *Volume of studies*: 4 weeks, 120 academic hours (teaching and practice / cultural events), 8 ECTS.
- *Groups* from A1 (beginners') to C1 (fluent speakers) according to CEFR.
- *Cultural and entertaining activities* are held after classes and include language practice: walking in the town and in the beach, visiting Lithuanian families, travelling across Lithuania. <https://www.ku.lt/studies/lithuanian-language-and-culture-courses/lithuanian-language-and-culture-summer-academy/course-programme/>
- *Teachers* also participate in the cultural events, helping their students to apply and reinforce their language knowledge and skills.
- *The certificate* (issued in LT and EN languages) indicates the level of studies, the mark and 8 ECTS awarded.
- *Accommodation* in a modern dormitory with all facilities (it's like a hotel, our students say), in a walking distance from the University.
- *Valuable knowledge, having a good time together, free hours in one of several beaches including Curonian Spit, a pearl of Lithuania. Useful contacts and new friends!*
