SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMS IN ASIA - STUDY & TRAVEL IN SUMMER 2019

Studying abroad is once-in-a-lifetime experience, and it's something that can positively impact both your personal and professional future. Many students who have studied abroad report afterwards that it was one of the best experiences in their whole life.

By joining an international summer school program, you get to experience a new country, learn the basics of a new language, gain friends from all over the world and

take some interesting courses at the same time, all within just a month. You can gain up to 10-12 ECTS in total, and you don't have to spend a fortune. You can also book accommodation through Asia Exchange so you don't have to worry about finding accommodation for the duration of the month.

You can now apply for our summer school programs in Bali, Indonesia or Seoul, South Korea. The one-month-long summer school programs introduce you to the local language and culture while giving you the opportunity to learn about many other interesting topics as well.

The International Summer Session at Hankuk University of Foreign Studies introduces you to Korean language and culture. Courses are also offered in the areas of performing arts, culture, economy and business, Asian politics, contemporary society and international relations.

The Warmadewa International Summer Exchange organized by Warmadewa University in Bali, Indonesia introduces you to Indonesian language, culture, tourism and business. You won't be just sitting in the classroom either, but will get to take part in many interesting workshops and excursions as well.

The application deadline for both summer schools is on the 31st of May.
