<p>A BRIEF EXPLANATION OF MAIN PROJECTS</p>	<p>The projects that the IMO office gets involved in are Residential (private villas), Interior Design (apartments), Façade Design, Educational and Public Government Projects.</p> <p>Xiafu Activity Center: The Xiafu Activity-Center is located directly adjacent the Hongfu-Gong Temple in, a symbol of Taiwan's rich and ancient cultural past. The project is an example of how architecture can be an important multi-generational intersection between the custodians of Taiwanese culture and the youth of the next generation, serving as a medium where culture can be interpreted, transferred and enjoyed. Xiafu demonstrates that architecture can fulfill more than just a utilitarian function, it can enhance and contribute to the positive development of a unique cultural identity and the subsequent vitally important unique perspectives that it produces.</p> <p>Taipei Weather Station This project is located in a natural environment: wet grass, sound of birds, the smell of the morning fog, old leafy trees... From the very beginning it was clear that the main challenge of the site was how to integrate a Weather Station in such a magnificent environment. This project achieved that dividing the Weather Station into 3 buildings and using an undulating roof to help those buildings establish a gentle relationship with the ground.</p> <p>Sanhong Façade One of the elements that we have noticed in Taiwanese residential buildings is that there is a big energy consumption due to a massive use of air conditioning throughout the year. This façade design for a residential building of 100 m. high addressed these issues. After a study of temperature, relative humidity, wind speed, global horizontal illumination, sky coverage, etc. this façade scheme guarantees a 34% of air conditioning reduction throughout every year compared to the original building</p>

	<p>design given by the client. This is not only an important energy and cost saving, it also optimizes the sustainability and comfort feeling in the building.</p> <p>Hotel in Suao Suao is the gateway to the natural East side of Taiwan. It is the place where the green of nature meets the blue Pacific, where the immovable central mountain range 中央山脈 meets the unstable and changing sea, where the unfathomable jungle meets the open ocean. This project explores this duality in the people who pass by Suao, a place where we want to look to the infinity and be in our own space, observe the force of the sea and feel protected, enjoy the agitation of the ocean and experience the tranquility of nature.</p>
<p>PREVIOUS COLLABORATION IN INTERNSHIP/TRAINING PROGRAMMES?</p>	<p>We have received interns from Escuela Técnica Superior de Arquitectura de San Sebastian (ETSASS, UPV-EHU) during years 2016,2017 and 2018. From NCKU, 國立成功大學 National Cheng Kung University in 2018. It is the first time that we get involved in an official program like Global Training.</p>
<p>OTHER COMMENTARIES</p>	<p>VISADOS: El Gobierno Taiwanés en los últimos 2 años está impulsando políticas para atraer a talento cualificado extranjero pero todavía falta un tiempo para ver si hay cambios sustanciales. Por el momento, el Gobierno facilita los visados de trabajo a extranjeros cualificados que tengan más de 5 años de experiencia. Los becarios por lo general, al no tener dicha experiencia es difícil que opten a esos visados, por lo que la práctica general es que entren con visados de turista. Los Europeos, no necesitan visado, pueden entrar directamente a Taiwán con su pasaporte todas las veces que quieran y pueden permanecer hasta 3 meses. Cada 3 meses lo que se hace es un Visa Round, que consiste en ir a un país vecino como Filipinas y volver en el día y suele costar aproximadamente unos 110€. También se suele aprovechar para ir otro país cercano como, Vietnam, Hong Kong, Japón, Tailandia etc. Esto permite al becario tener un poco más de conocimiento de Asia y sin duda enriquecer su experiencia.
