For Incoming Students to CSUMB:

- CSUMB's course delivery method will be through virtual instruction for the fall 2020 term, with few limited exceptions for in-person instructional and research activities that cannot be delivered in an alternate modality and are essential to the university's core mission. For these activities, we will maintain rigorous standards of health and safety.
 - Students that have already been admitted or nominated for the fall 2020 semester will be emailed to choose from the following options:
 - Defer admission to Spring 2021 semester, to take in-person classes in January
 - 2. Withdraw their application entirely
 - 3. Take CSUMB course(s) online from their home country
