Program Structure	Intensive German language module with the duration of four weeks + one academic module (four options are provided) In each module two seminars and a supplement course are offered.

ECTS	9
Language of instruction	is English. All students interested to improve their German language skills beyond the German class may do so by taking the module "EU-Germany-Middle East", one seminar in this module will be taught in German.
New in 2014!	 Module structure: broader range of topics covered by the seminars, all taught by the University's leading academics and international experts. New supplement courses: Hebrew, Turkish, and Arabic language courses; German culture course. German language class has been extended and will comprise 45 hours.
	The field trip to France has been extended to three days.
