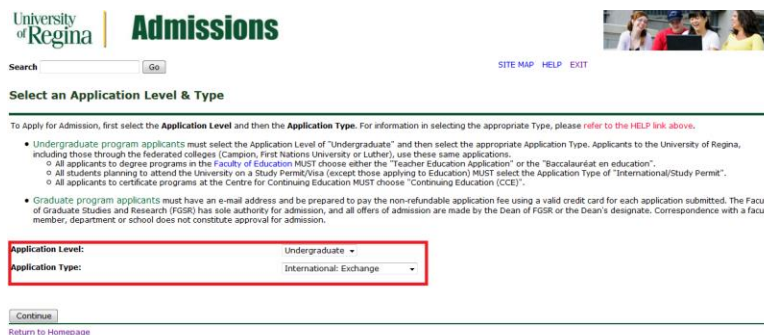
Inbound Exchange Student Checklist

Hi there! If you're reading this, that means you're coming to the University of Regina on an exchange term. Congratulations, and we can't wait to meet you! We've taken the time to detail some of the steps of your application process for your exchange to make it as easy and stress-free as possible for you.



Exchange Admission Process

- ❑ Be nominated by your school to the University of Regina
- ❑ Online application for admission to the U of R:
https://banner.uregina.ca/prod/sct/bwskalog.p_disloginnew
 - Ensure that you select “**exchange**” student for your application, or it may get lost!

Select an Application Level & Type

To Apply for Admission, first select the **Application Level** and then the **Application Type**. For information in selecting the appropriate Type, please refer to the [HELP link above](#).

- Undergraduate program applicants must select the Application Level of "Undergraduate" and then select the appropriate Application Type. Applicants to the University of Regina, including those through the federated colleges (Campion, First Nations University or Luther), use these same applications.
 - All applicants to degree programs in the Faculty of Education MUST choose either the "Teacher Education Application" or the "Baccalaureat en education".
 - All students planning to attend the University on a Study Permit/Visa (except those applying to Education) MUST select the Application Type of "International/Study Permit".
 - All applicants to certificate programs at the Centre for Continuing Education MUST choose "Continuing Education (CCE)".
- Graduate program applicants must have an e-mail address and be prepared to pay the non-refundable application fee using a valid credit card for each application submitted. The Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research (FGSR) has sole authority for admission, and all offers of admission are made by the Dean of FGSR or the Dean's designate. Correspondence with a faculty member, department or school does not constitute approval for admission.

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- ❑ **Please note that as an exchange student you are not required to pay the CAD\$ 100 application fee.**
- ❑ Submit the following documents to our office immediately after applying for admission via email to the Study Abroad Office at study.abroad@uregina.ca – don't forget to include your first and last name!
 - Copy of your passport photo page
 - Conditions of placement
 - Course request list
 - Official transcript in English (French transcripts may be sent without translation)*
*If your transcript will be delayed, please send the other documents as soon as possible. We can wait for the transcript for a short time.
- ❑ To fill out the course request list, use the following two links:
 - Searchable course catalogue (not always available for semesters too far in advance): https://banner.uregina.ca/prod/sct/bwckschd.p_disp_dyn_sched
- ❑ Wait for your acceptance letter! Depending on the processing times, this may take around two (2) weeks or more, and will be sent to you via email, as well as in the mail.



To ensure quick processing of your acceptance letter:

Things to Do:

- ❑ Ensure your school has submitted the nomination form (if it hasn't been submitted, we can't accept you!)
- ❑ Send a copy of your passport immediately after applying
- ❑ Submit your course request list immediately after applying

Things NOT to Do:

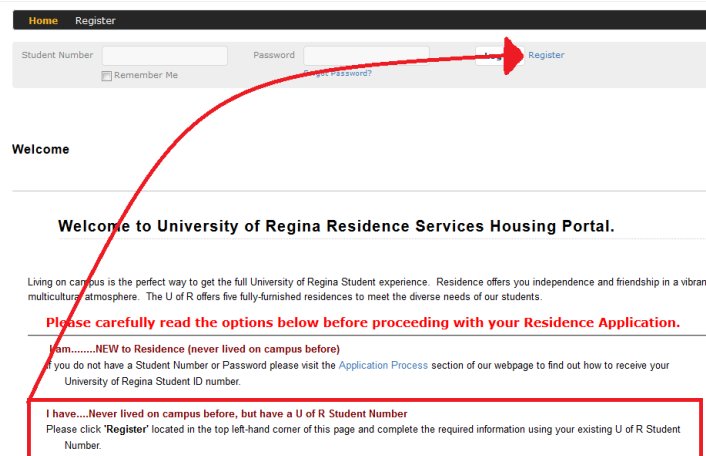
- ❑ Submit more than one admission application
- ❑ Send emails asking if your letter is ready before 2 weeks



Housing Application Checklist

You cannot apply for housing before you have a student ID number from the UofR. If you've already submitted your application for admission, please email the Study Abroad office to be provided with your student ID number.

- If you will be staying for one semester, please ensure that you have clearly stated this on your residence application
- Confirm with the Study Abroad office at the following times:
 - After you've submitted your residence application
 - After you've received your housing agreement from Residence Services (or Luther College Residence)



Transportation

- ❑ Book flights coming into Regina International Airport (airport code YQR)
- ❑ Have Canadian cash on your person, (approximate cost will be \$20-\$30)
- ❑ Take a taxi from the airport to your residence at the University of Regina (10 minutes' drive)
 - When you are in the lobby of the airport after arrival, there are airport officials who can direct you to finding a taxi
- ❑ If arriving before move-in date, pay fee for early move-in*

***Important note:** If you will be moving in before the official move-in dates of Residence, or if you will be arriving at to Regina outside of normal working hours (which at the UofR are 8:15 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.), you will need to contact Residence Services to make special arrangements to get into your room. Please contact them at Housing.Services@uregina.ca. If you are in Luther College Residence, please make special arrangements with them directly.



Other:

- ❑ It is mandatory for students who will be living on campus to attend Campus Residence Orientation, so please ensure that your travel will get you here on time
- ❑ It is also mandatory for exchange students to be present on UR International Orientation Day, so similarly, please ensure that your travel will allow you to arrive in time for that (we will send out emails in advance to let you know of the date and time)
- ❑ Students coming to the University of Regina on exchange **MUST** get health insurance from their home country to cover their medical expenses while here on exchange
