

It is the official seat of the EU and many other political and economic decision-making entities, and boasts a growing number of businesses, organisations and international experts.</p> <p>With around 180.000 inhabitants divided among the different neighborhoods that form the city, Brussels offers all the advantages of a capital city and the quality of life of a large and lively town.</p> <p>The long tradition as a destination for people from all around the globe makes Brussels an incredibly international city, with a 33% of its population being of a foreign origin. This means that both visitors and residents can feel easily comfortable and enjoy a broad cultural offer.</p> <p>EURATEX is located on the heart of the European district, only some meters away from the European Parliament and surrounded by some of the most important directorates of the European Commission and the national representation headquarters of many countries.</p> <p>The different neighborhoods of the city are well connected through several tram, bus and metro lines, for which monthly passes are available.</p> <p>As for the accommodation, the price range is quite broad depending on different factors such as the neighborhood in which it is located, the conditions of the building or whether the home is shared with other people or not.
