<b>INFORMATION ABOUT THE CITY AND THE AREA WHERE THE COMPANY/INSTITUTION IS LOCATED</b>  (General information about SECURITY, ACCOMODATION, PUBLIC TRANSPORT...)	<p>Trainees will receive a “welcome kit” as part of their orientation and induction outlining general information about the city.</p> <p>Ormston House is located in the heart of Limerick City and on the edge of a key zone for regeneration under the Limerick 2030 economic and spatial plan. The city centre was awarded the Purple Flag for providing a vibrant and diverse mix of dining, entertainment and culture while promoting safety and well-being of visitors and local residents. The average monthly rent for a room in shared accommodation is €600. Ormston House will assist the trainee with temporary accommodation on arrival (up to two weeks) and support with finding suitable accommodation for the duration of the traineeship. The city centre is manageable on foot however there is also a public bicycle scheme, a bus service, an intercity train service, and an international airport 20 minutes from the city.</p>

Our programme is co-designed with artists and citizens, resulting in community partnerships, multi-annual projects and cultural events that are responsive to the city and its context. We have developed a participatory model to connect curatorial practice with local knowledge and activism.</p> <p>Ormston House is part of the <a href="#">Irish Network Against Racism</a> and the <a href="#">Public Participation Network</a>. International connectivity is also key to our work, and we are active members of three European networks: <a href="#">Artists' Initiatives Meetings</a>, <a href="#">River Cities Platform</a>, and <a href="#">Trans Europe Halles</a>. We are based at 9-10 Patrick Street, where we have a long-term lease from Limerick City &amp; County Council.</p>
