RESOLUCIÓN DE 29 DE JUNIO DE 2022, DE LA VICERRECTORA DE EUSKERA, CULTURA E INTERNACIONALIZACIÓN, POR LA QUE SE APRUEBAN LAS BASES DE LA CONVOCATORIA PARA LA SELECCIÓN DEL PERSONAL PARTICIPANTE EN EL PROYECTO ERASMUS+ 2020 DE LA UPV/EHU, PARA MOVILIDAD DESDE UNIVERSIDADES DE CANADÁ Y ESTADOS UNIDOS A LA UPV/EHU (SEGUNDA CONVOCATORIA DEL PROYECTO 2020).

2020ko ekainean, Hezkuntza Nazioartekotzeko Espainiako Zerbitzuak (SEPIE) argitaratu zuen 2020ko deialdian Erasmus+ programako herrialdeen eta herrialde kideen arteko mugikortasunerako finantzabidea lortu duten unibertsitateen zerrenda.

En junio de 2020, el Servicio Español para la Internacionalización de la Educación (SEPIE) publicó el listado de universidades que obtuvieron financiación para la movilidad entre países del programa Erasmus+ y países asociados en la convocatoria del año 2020.

Deialdi horretan UPV/EHUk finantzabidea lortu zuen, pertsonala 2020-21, 2021-22 eta 2022-23 ikasturteetan, besteak beste, toki hauetara edota hauetatik mugitzeko: Kanada eta Estatu Batuak.

En dicha convocatoria la UPV/EHU obtuvo financiación para movilidades de personal, durante los cursos 2020-21, 2021-22 y 2022-23, con, entre otros, los siguientes países: Canadá y Estados Unidos.

Beraz, orain UPV/EHUk mugikortasun hori UPV/EHUra egitera etorriko diren Kanadako eta Estatu Batuetako langileak aukeratu behar ditu.

En consecuencia, la UPV/EHU debe proceder a seleccionar al personal de Canadá y Estados Unidos que realizará dichas movilidades a la UPV/EHU.

Lehena.- Kanadako eta Estatu Batuetako unibertsitateetatik UPV/EHUra mugikortasuna eginez, Erasmus+ programan parte hartuko duten langileak aukeratzeko deialdiaren oinarriak onartu eta argitaratzea.

2020 proiektuko langileen mugikortasunerako bigarren deialdia da honako hau.

Bigarrena.- Erabaki honek administrazio bidea agortzen du. Hala ere, haren aurka aukerako berraztertze errekurtsua aurkeztu ahal zaio Koordinazioaren eta Nazioarteko Harremanen arloko errektoreordeari, hilabeteko epean, erabakia UPV/EHUko webgunean argitaratu eta hurrengo egunetik hasita, hori guztia, Administrazio Publikoaren Administrazio Prozedura Erkidearen urriaren 1eko 39/2015 Legearen arabera (123 eta 124 artikulua); bestela, administrazioarekiko auzi errekurtsua jar daiteke zuzenean administrazioarekiko auzietako Bilboko epaitegietan bi hilabeteko epean, erabakia UPV/EHUko webgune ofizialean argitaratzen denetik hasita, administrazioarekiko auzien jurisdikzioa arautzen duen uztailaren 13ko 29/1998 Legearen arabera (8.3 eta 46.1 artikulua).

RESUELVO:

Primero. - Aprobar y publicar las bases de la convocatoria de movilidad Erasmus+ para el personal para movilizaciones desde universidades de Canadá y Estados Unidos a la UPV/EHU.

Esta es la segunda convocatoria para movilidad de personal del proyecto 2020.

Segundo. - La presente Resolución pone fin a la vía administrativa. No obstante, contra la misma cabe interponer recurso potestativo de reposición ante la Vicerrectora de Coordinación y Relaciones Internacionales en el plazo de un mes, contado a partir del día siguiente al de su publicación en la Web de la UPV/EHU, de conformidad con lo dispuesto en los artículos 123 y 124 de la Ley 39/2015, de 1 de octubre, del Procedimiento Administrativo Común de las Administraciones Públicas, o directamente recurso contencioso-administrativo ante los juzgados de lo Contencioso-Administrativo de Bilbao en el plazo de dos meses, contados desde el día siguiente al de su publicación en la Web oficial de la UPV/EHU, conforme a lo establecido en los artículos 8.3 y 46.1 de la Ley 29/1998, de 13 de julio, reguladora de la Jurisdicción Contencioso-Administrativa.

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS TO SELECT STAFF TO TAKE PART IN UPV/EHU'S ERASMUS+ 2022 PROJECT FOR MOBILITY FROM UNIVERSITIES IN CANADA AND UNITED STATES TO UPV/EHU (SPAIN). Second call of the 2020 project.

1.- Object of the process

The aim of this call is to select the staff that will take part in UPV/EHU's Erasmus+ 2020 project for mobility from universities in Canada and United States to UPV/EHU (Spain).

2.- Universities taking part

The mobility envisaged in this process can be from the following universities to UPV/EHU:

- **CANADA**

- Concordia University
- University of British Columbia

- **UNITES STATES OF AMERICA**

- San Diego State University
- California State University, Bakersfield
- Lenoir-Rhyne University
- North Carolina State University, Raleigh

3.- Type of mobility

The offered mobilities are Erasmus+ training mobilities.

The aims of these mobilities are the following:

- To facilitate the observation of good practices of the universities taking part in UPV/EHU's Staff Training Week for staff working in international student and/or staff mobility, scheduled for 24-28 October 2022.
- To strengthen relations between partner universities.

4.- Places offered

This call for applications aims to select staff interested in the following vacancies:

5.- Features of the Erasmus+ grants

The maximum period financed by the Erasmus+ programme will be **five days, plus** additional two day for travel days, and an amount for **travel expenses** depending on the distance.

- (1) *The first travel day (additional 160) can only be paid if the person arrives to Spain the 23rd of October 2022.*
- (2) *The second travel day (additional 160) can only be paid if the person goes back to his/her country on the 29th of October 2022.*

6.- Period in which the mobility can take place

Mobilities must take place between the 24th of October 2022 and the 28th of October 2022.

7.- Requirements to take part

Candidates must meet the following conditions:

- a) They must be on the payroll of one of the universities taking part, both at the time of applying and at the time of the mobility.
- b) They must have the approval of their university of origin for the work plan included in the provisional Mobility Agreement for Training (Annexe I).

8.- Application

Applications must be individual.

Each application must be sent using the following form:

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Besides, the following documents must be sent via email to pc.international@ehu.eus :

1. Provisional work plan (Mobility Agreement for Training – Annexe I, signed by the home university and the applicant).
2. Curriculum Vitae of the applicant.
3. Document that proves that the applicant is an employee of his/her home university.

9.- Application period

The application period will begin on the 30th of June 2022 and will end on the 11th of July 2022.

10.- Assessment committee

The committee to assess the applications received will be made up of the following people: The Director of International Mobility, the Head of the International Relations Service and a project officer of the International Relations Office (as secretary to the committee).

UPV/EHU will ask applicants' universities of origin for their assessment of each of the candidatures received.

11.- Assessment criteria

The following criteria will be used to select participants:

1. Rating of the work plan proposed in the provisional mobility agreement, from 1 to 10.
2. Rating of the candidate sent by the university of origin, from 1 to 5.

Each applicant must score at least 11 points in order to be a candidate for one of the places available.

12.- Resolution

The Vice-Rector for Basque Culture and Internationalization will, in view of the list of priorities prepared by the committee, order the publication of the mobility applications accepted and those placed on the waiting list.

However, applicants will be notified individually at the email address they gave in their application and given a period of 10 working days to accept or waive the mobility.

13.- Erasmus+ grant agreement

People selected to take part in the mobility must first sign a Grant Agreement setting forth the rights and obligations they must take on as beneficiaries of an Erasmus+ grant for staff.

14.- Obligatory insurance for participants

Before travelling, the participant must send UPV/EHU a copy of a document proving they have travel insurance, including accident cover, medical expenses, medical transfer and repatriation.

15.- Beneficiaries' duties

Non-compliance with the rules and/or periods shown in the call for application or the grant agreement, or any concealment, alteration or tampering with information may be grounds for rejection, suspension or cancellation of the grant awarded, leading to an obligation to return any sums handed over.

The International Relations Office may ask beneficiaries and universities of origin for whatever documents it sees fit in order to verify that the mobility has taken place in accordance with the spirit of the round of applications.

17. Signature of the Erasmus+ agreement

If an Erasmus+ agreement for mobility with partner countries has not been signed before the mobility date between the home university of the participant and UPV/EHU, the potential beneficiary will not be allowed to carry out the mobility and he/she will not be able to claim any Erasmus+ funding. In this case, the award of the Erasmus+ mobility to this person will be considered as revoked.

This clause affects to: San Diego State University, North Carolina State University and California State University, Bakersfield.
