IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS TO TRAVEL AND ENTER CANADA

• Students studying LESS than 6 months (one semester)

Students must be fully vaccinated to enter Canada in order to take a course or program regardless of the length of studies.

Students studying in Canada for 6 months or less, are eligible to enter Canada as visitors. and are required to have a Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) or a Temporary Residence Visa (TRV). Students may assess whether they need an eTA or TRV using this link: https://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/visas.asp. Please note, processing time for TRV applications remains long as a result of COVID-19 related service disruptions. CUE cannot guarantee that applications will process in time for students to begin their studies for the Winter 2023 semester.

NOTE: Students who will study in Canada for just one semester are not required to apply for a study permit. However, students may apply for a study permit even if they do not need one. Exchange students who have a study permit may work on-campus provided they are authorized by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) to be able to do so. **Please note, CUE is a small campus and opportunities for on-campus employment are limited.

Students studying MORE than 6 months (two semesters)

Students studying for more than 6 months in Canada are required to have a study permit. The study permit application fee is \$150 (CAD) and is a non-refundable fee paid to the Government of Canada. CUE is not liable for the cost of the study permit application and will not reimburse students whose study permit applications are not approved.

The study permit processing time has been impacted by COVID-19. Students who need a study permit are recommended to apply immediately after being admitted to CUE.
