The Canadian Summer Seminar offered by Concordia University of Edmonton is an intensive international summer school which provides students with the opportunity to broaden their knowledge of the English language while immersing themselves in their field of study, be it public health or business.

Morning sessions offer intensive English courses for students with an intermediate level of the language, taught by a certified instructor with a Master's Degree in English as a Second Language (ESL).

Afternoon sessions offer either a series of academic lectures on the Canadian Public Health system or a Business Emphasis with courses taught by professors in Human Resources, Information Systems Security, Accounting and Retail.

Classes take place at Concordia University of Edmonton's beautiful riverside campus, minutes away from the vibrant downtown city core.
