The Library was founded in the late sixties under the auspices of the Basque Studies Program by then coordinator, William Douglass, with the help of Robert Laxalt, and guidance of Jon Bilbao. Today, the Basque Library is a part of the University of Nevada, Reno's main library.</p> <p>Nowadays, the Basque Library serves the information needs of the Center for Basque Studies of the UNR, North American researchers interested in Basque Culture, and the Basque Diaspora as its memory institution.</p>
