Credit points and Grading Scale	
Number of study hours per Credit Point: The academic load is the number of hours required to obtain approval in different disciplines. Normally the load corresponding to an academic discipline is equivalent to 04 credits or 60 hours a semester. There are disciplines with academic loads of 30, 45 and 120 hours. 1 credit = 15 hours of class. Example: one discipline = 60 hours of class = 16 weeks = 4 credits	Grading scale: 0 to 10

Application Documents	<p>The basic documentation to be submitted to participate in the International Academic Mobility Program is available below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Registration form for the exchange at UFPE (Also available on the website - link above), describing the study plan to be conducted at UFPE, describing each of chosen disciplines with name and code (available here), signed by the Home Institution.• Updated school transcript; It is recommended that students register in a maximum of five disciplines. <p>All of these documents must be signed and sent to: mobilidade.in@ufpe.br</p>	



EXCHANGE REQUIREMENTS

Language requirements	It is important to remember that all lessons are taught in Portuguese, so all of the students should have intermediate knowledge of Portuguese. An official Language Certificate is, however, not a requirement.
Medical insurance requirement	All foreign students must enter Brazil in possession of Health Insurance .
GPA	There is not an exact GPA required, which is why the student must send, along with the application form, his transcript of records, so that the coordinators of the courses he applies to can analyze his academic performance.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Visa requirements (recommended website)	<p>To participate in the International Academic Mobility Program or any other activity offered by UFPE, it is necessary that the students obtain the proper visa, valid throughout the period of permanence in Brazil, which should be obtained from the Consular Division of the Brazilian Embassy or the Brazilian Consulate in the student's home country, before leaving.</p> <p>It is recommended that the request must be made in advance. It may take awhile from the processing of documents until the granting of the appropriate visa. Without the visa, the student cannot validate their registration at UFPE.</p> <p>It is important to notice that it is not possible for the exchange student to enroll at UFPE if he only holds a touristic visa. There is also no possibility of switching the kind of visa you have after your arrival in Brazil. It would be necessary to leave the country before getting a new visa, so the student must not leave his country before receiving the student visa.</p> <p>As a general rule, the following documents will be necessary to issue the visa:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Acceptance Letter from UFPE<input type="checkbox"/> Valid Passport<input type="checkbox"/> Certificate of residence in the Consular Jurisdiction<input type="checkbox"/> 4x4 recent photo (with white background)<input type="checkbox"/> Visa application form (available at the Brazilian Consulate in student's home country)<input type="checkbox"/> Consular fee (check directly at the Consulate in the student's country, since it can vary from country to country) <p>The required documents may change, so the student must check with the consulate of his/her country in order to obtain an updated list of documents necessary for obtaining the student visa.</p>
Academic costs of an exchange student / General expenses per month	UFPE is a public university and does not charge tuition fees. Students should however be responsible for providing the costs for: airline tickets, accommodation, local transportation, food, study material, and leisure. The average monthly budget suggested is around R\$ 2,000.00 (two thousand reais)
Accommodation	Although UFPE does not provide accommodation for foreign students, we offer a list of places where they can stay (at least for the first weeks in



	Recife). The Accommodation List is available at our Student Guide .
Additional services offered for exchange students	<p>- Buddy Program: is a program created by the International Office in order to improve the relationship between international students and the academic community. The Buddy (a volunteer regular undergraduate student at UFPE) is chosen to help the international student with the bureaucratic procedures he has to deal with upon arrival, such as enrollment at the university and obtaining the students card.</p> <p>- Access to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- 1 Central library + 12 sectorial libraries;- 1 Restaurant + 6 Snack Bars;- Physical Education and Sports Centre- WiFi around Campus
