Student Support

Students who choose to do their exchange semester (or year) at LR are supported from start to finish. After being met at the airport by staff, they are transported to campus where they check-in to their residence hall rooms (prepared with sheets, blankets, pillows, towels and more). Students also participate in a New Exchange Student Orientation with staff from the SCIE to learn about immigration and university requirements as well as oncampus facilities and programs. They will also be paired with, and supported by, a local student mentor who will help them get acquainted with campus life and the local community.

Throughout the semester and academic year, students have the opportunity to participate in many programs sponsored by the SCIE, such as coffee breaks, mocktail hours, monthly excursions to cities in the region, game nights, karaoke nights, cooking workshops and much more.

Academic Offerings

While LRU boasts three campuses: Hickory, Asheville and Columbia, exchange students can only enroll in courses on LR's main campus in Hickory, NC. Students can enroll in a variety of course offerings from various degree programs at the undergraduate and graduate level.

While on exchange, students will enroll in a minimum of 12 US credits (typically the equivalent of four courses).

Room and Board

Incoming exchange students are housed in the Global Village in the Living Learning Center, an apartment-style residence hall. The community is comprised of a mixture of U.S. and international students. Inside each apartment unit are four bedrooms (single and double occupancy), a bathroom, living room, and small kitchen equipped with a mini-fridge, microwave and four burner stove. In the Living Learning Center, or LLC, students have access to laundry facilities, vending machines, study lounges including a computer lab, a conference room, as well as an outdoor basketball court.

Students have access to a meal plan which includes unlimited meals in the campus dining hall, as well as meal exchanges at other on-campus restaurants such as Chick-Fil-A and Joe's Coffee.

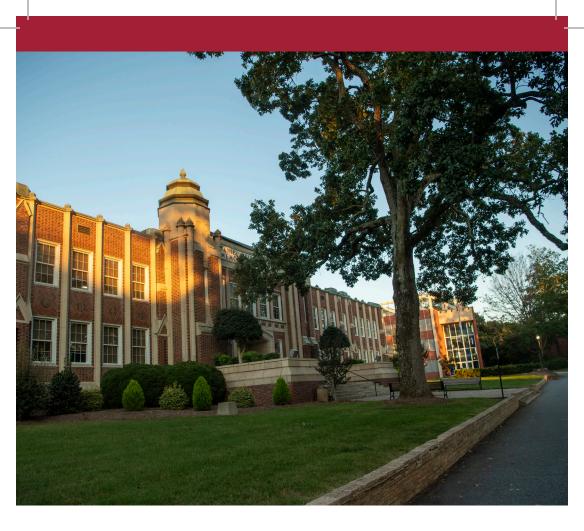
Application deadlines:

Costs

Exchange students enjoy free tuition when studying at LR. Students are responsible for paying the room and board fee and international insurance fee, totaling around \$7,000 USD.
