Brest campus

Spend three weeks in Brest, on the Western tip of Brittany learning the French culture and language!

Every year, IMT Atlantique (ex Telecom Bretagne), one of the major graduate engineering colleges in Western France, organizes a French Language Summer School for incoming international students on its campus in Brest.

The classes are taught in small multicultural groups from all over the world. During the five daily hours of classes with French native-speaker teachers, you are encouraged to participate, in an intercultural environment, using role-play, games and multimedia.

You will take advantage of our impressive seaside campus with many cultural and sporting activities including visits, water sports and rock climbing. You will also have the opportunity to discover Western France's most beautiful historical sites.



French courses

If you want to learn or perfect your French, our Summer School is perfect for you as it offers **different groups organized by levels**. In order to optimize interaction in the class and encourage your progress, the groups are composed of a **maximum of 12 students**.

Many educational activities and a vast range of resources are at your disposal to help you get to grips with the French culture.

Thanks to the 20 nationalities present on the campus each year you will have the **opportunity to work on an intercultural exchange**.

The **three-week courses** include:

- Listening and reading activities
- Grammar and linguistics works
- Phonetics with games
- Writing exercises
- Oral presentations in groups
- An educational visit of Brest
- Intercultural workshops to discover your friends' cultures
- New: a drama activity to improve your public speaking

Classes are taught from 9am to 12pm and from 1.30pm to 3.30pm

Students who complete this course successfully will be awarded 2 ECTS and will receive an attendance certificate.

Sport

Our **vast well equipped campus** and its **prime location on the coast** will offer you many possibilities to try out sports such as sailing, surfing, kayaking, rock climbing and many others which will give you an excellent opportunity to have fun while speaking French!

Visits & Activities



You will take part in an **educational visit around Brest led** by our French teachers in order to learn about the city's major historical events and help you get acquainted with the various places in Brest.

Discover a **traditional Breton market** and **several nearby cities** and explore the **GR34 coastal path**, with its breathtaking views.

Attend **Brest's main summer musical event** – Les Juedis du Port – and enjoy the sound of local bands playing on the quays. Become truly Breton by participating in a **Fest-Noz** and taste many traditional Breton culinary specialities!

Accommodation & Campus

During these three weeks, **the students live on campus at the Maisel** (student residences) **in individual bedrooms**. Shared cooking facilities are provided or you can also enjoy the quality of our local products in our restaurant. Meet new people and relax after your classes in the friendly atmosphere of the **student common room**.

Erasmus Student Network members will help you settle in and will also organize plenty of activities or themed parties in the common room.

Fees are **800€ including meals, visits and French medical cover**.
