

Basque Graduate Scholarships



In coordination with the Basque Studies Program and the Boise Basque Museum & Cultural Center, Boise State University's Civil Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical and Computer Engineering, Geosciences and Geophysics, Materials Science and Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering Graduate Programs are proud to offer scholarships to qualified Master of Science (M.S.) and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) applicants from the Basque Country. The Basque Graduate Scholarship Program was established to promote the strong connection between the Basque Country, Boise, Idaho and Boise State University. The scholarships, also known as assistantships, provide students \$18,000-\$25,000 per year plus full payment of tuition and health insurance premiums.

Students that have a Bachelor of Science degree (M.S. Applicants), or a Master of Science degree or Licenciatura (Ph.D. Applicants) in any engineering field, computer science, physics, earth sciences, chemistry, the life sciences, or mathematics by May 2016 are encouraged to apply for Fall 2016 admissions.

How to Apply:

- 1. Submit the preliminary application by email to Mr. Chad Watson (<u>chadwatson1@boisestate.edu</u>). The preliminary application enables candidates to apply to a graduate program of interest prior to taking the GRE and TOEFL exams and without incurring any expenses. Submit by 15 February 2016 and include the following:
 - a completed application form
 - · resume or curriculum vitae
 - unofficial transcripts
 - three letters of recommendation from professors
 - a statement of purpose no longer than two pages describing your education and technical background, motivation for graduate study, research interests and career goals.
- 2. Based off the merits of submitted preliminary applications, Graduate Programs will make scholarship recommendations. Notifications are expected to be made by 15 April 2016. Applicants recommended for the Basque Graduate Scholarship will be invited to submit a formal application. The application process can be initiated by going to http://graduatecollege.boisestate.edu/howtoapply/. Upon satisfactorily completing the application and demonstrating adequate levels in the GRE and the TOEFL English language proficiency exams, a scholarship offer will be made pending an admissions recommendation from the Graduate Program and approval by the Dean of the Graduate College.
