

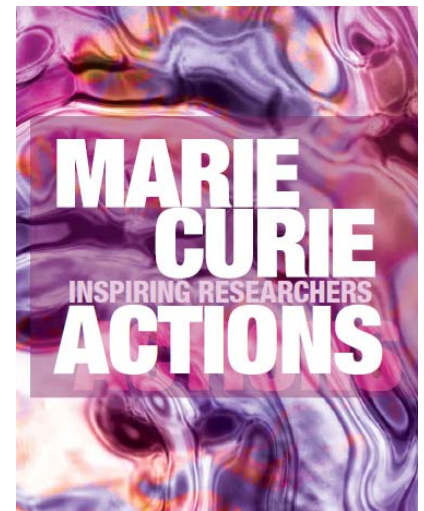

Overview of the Workshop

This workshop will present an overview of FP7 Marie Curie Funding and will provide practical tips for researchers or host organisations planning to submit a proposal for **Individual Fellowships** in 2013.

What is Marie Curie Funding?

Marie Curie funding is awarded to European or International researchers in order to help further their research career, or enable them to transfer their knowledge to another research group. The host organisation is normally a research-active university, institute, or company.

When is the proposal deadline?

The Call is planned to be announced on 14 March 2013. The EC Call Deadline for submissions is scheduled for **14 August 2013**.

Who should attend the workshop?

Researchers, academic supervisors, research managers and administrators, technology transfer managers, or R&D managers from institutes or companies.

The workshop will be presented by **Dr. Catherine Halbert**. She is an experienced EC Evaluator and has been involved in scientific research management for over 20 years. She specialises in FP7 funding programmes, and has helped researchers and host organisations to win Marie Curie funding and run successful projects.

***Pre-booked mentoring sessions will follow the workshop. It is advisable that participants complete the One-Page Proposal Template in advance of the workshop.**
