Programación para el desarrollo de la evaluación de la asignatura en formato no-presencial

Ikasgaia lehenengo lauhilekoa denez edukiak bere osotasunean irakatsi dira. Irakaskuntza bi ataletan bananduta dago eta bi atalak gainditu behar dira ikasgaia gainditzeko. Ondoren atal bakoitzeko *ez-ohiko ebaluazioari* buruzko zeheztasunak azalduko dira.

PART I: LITERATURE & CULTURE (7 weeks)

1.1. CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT:

- a) Questions about the readings: 15%

The final exam has been substituted by some questions about the readings of the syllabus. The students must answer to one of the questions already available on the platform.

- b) Class participation, individual work, Groupwork (presentation, essay,...) 30%

1.2. FINAL EVALUATION

- a) Questions about the readings: 25%

The final exam has been substituted by some questions about the readings of the syllabus. The students must answer to one of the questions already available on the platform.

- b) Essay: 20% .

The students are required to produce an academic essay following APA editing rules and the language requirements of the scientific and academic forms of formal English addressing one of the topics of discussion.

NOTES:

- Both assignments must be turned in on Egela before the official exam date (June 17th, 12:00)
- Both the questions part and the essay must be passed in order to pass this part of the subject.

PART II: COMMUNICATION & CULTURE (8 weeks) 55%

2.1. CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT

2.1.1. GROUP WORK:

- Listening and Reading tasks 4%
- Story 3%
- Video 5%
- Oral presentation 10%

2.1.2. INDIVIDUAL WORK:

- Journal 5%

On the exam official date (June 17th), students will do the following through Blackboard collaborate:

- Listening test :critical summary 15%**
- Cover letter writing 13%**

2.2. FINAL ASSESSMENT

On the exam official date (June 17th), students will do the following through Blackboard collaborate:

- Listening test: critical summary 20%**
- Cover letter writing 15%**
- Story reading aloud and presentation (speaking) 20%**

Both the written part (Listening test and cover letter) and oral part (reading aloud and presentation) have to be passed in order to pass this part of the subject.

OHARRAK

- The subject will be passed **only if both PART I and PART II have been passed independently**. Otherwise, marks from the continuous evaluation will be kept for the extraordinary call, but in no case for the following academic year.
