[Udako Euskal Unibertsitatea](#) (UEU), through the newly created GOI center, a centre attached to the UPV/EHU, will offer the next academic year 2020-21 the Master's Degree in *Teacher Training for Compulsory Secondary Education, Upper Secondary Education, Vocational Training and Foreign Language Teaching* in the **blended learning modality** and in **Basque**.

The 3 specialities of the Master's in its blended learning modality are:

- **Humanities and Social Sciences**
- **Natural Sciences and Mathematics**
- **Language & Literature**

The general organisation of the Master will be as follows:

A maximum of 40 students will be admitted in each speciality, i.e. a total of 120.

Online offer and Innovation in the Classroom

In this blended learning modality, classes will be taught through the **Virtual Classroom**. With this tool, the student will have at his or her disposal at all times the didactic and complementary materials necessary for the acquisition and development of the established competences. At the same time, the Virtual Classroom will offer students all the tools and resources they need to develop and evaluate their studies.

On the other hand, in each speciality, an optional itinerary is proposed focusing on the subject **Innovation in the Classroom**. This subject has a duration of **6 ECTS** and will be offered in the Innovation and Research module of each speciality as an optional itinerary. The subject will be developed in the educational centre, adapted to the needs of the centre, and in a practical way. Due to the characteristics of the itinerary, only **10 students will be admitted in each speciality**.



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Who is it for?

This type of blended learning can be attractive for students who, despite being interested in studying, cannot approach physically with a certain frequency. Thereby, new possibilities are opened up for them. Currently, this is the only offer of this degree in Basque that can be carried out online through the public university.

Characteristics of the modality. Summary

- Partially online training, with synchronous and asynchronous learning environments and activities.
- The internships will take place in the educational centres.
- The master's degree will be taught entirely in Basque.
- Each speciality will accommodate a maximum of 40 students in order to guarantee personalised attention and the quality of the training.
- The teaching activities and their evaluation have been adapted to the blended learning modality in order to guarantee the acquisition of all the skills proposed.
- In order to deepen the linguistic competences of the Master's students, a subject in English will be offered as an optional subject for each of the specialities.
- Innovation in the Classroom subjects (one per speciality): In each of the specialities, within the module of Teaching Innovation and Initiation to Educational Research, a subject of Innovation in the Classroom has been included, for a maximum of 10 students per speciality. The selected student body will take the Innovation in the Classroom course (6 ECTS) in a practical way and in a face-to-face mode in the educational centre where they will subsequently take the Practicum.
