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MULTILINGUALISM

The Faculty of Education, Philosophy and Anthropology offers degrees built on the premise of multilingualism. The degrees in Pedagogy, Social Education, Philosophy and Anthropology can be taken both in Euskera and in Spanish.

In the Early Education and Primary Education degrees, the main language is Euskera, but 10% of the courses (24 credits) must be taken in Spanish.

We also offer several subjects in English in addition to the official languages.

MOBILITY PROGRAMMES

Double Degree: PRIMARY EDUCATION + EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

Area of Knowledge: Social and Legal Sciences

When you do the Double Degree, you are doing two degrees: Early Childhood Education and Primary Education, and in five years, when you have completed it, you will acquire both certificates. Therefore, the characteristics and objectives of the entire 0-12 cycle of child education will be ensured along the course of the double degree.

In the Double Degree, in an autonomous group of 40 students, you will get theoretical and practical academic training to face this great challenge. You will acquire the necessary tools to contribute to the personal development of children through topics of pedagogical, psychological, scientific, ethical and social fields, together with linguistic, motor, mathematical and technological content. And during the five years, you will also have four school-internships or Practicum stays

To this end, a five-year proposal has been designed to ensure the training process of the two grades and to give students the chance to take one of the minor or specializations offered in the last year of the Primary Education degree (Special Education or Foreign Language Teaching with different job opportunities) or, in a more general instance, Euskera, Educational Instrument or Educational Innovation Projects in Primary Education

Area of knowledge: Social and Legal Sciences

Social Anthropology studies the human experience, its diversity in time and space, and social phenomena such as contemporary socio-economic inequality; ethnic, class, gender, religious and generational identity; immigration and social policies, complex aspects of popular and traditional cultures, and the effects of socio-cultural change.

The degree in Social Anthropology will provide you with the theoretical and practical tools necessary to analyse the complexity of social life. It will prepare you to apply this knowledge to the research and comprehension of relations between different societies and cultures and to analyse current questions through fieldwork and intervention. You will ultimately have a broad, detailed and multi-focal picture of society. Moreover, mandatory internship in the fourth year will give you first-hand in-depth knowledge of the work done by anthropologists.

This degree will train you to...

Get acquainted with social sciences theoretical grounds, specifically in Anthropology; be able to assess and explain human institutions, carry out ethnographic research based on field work, interpret cultural diversity through textual analysis and understand methodological and technical foundations of anthropological professional practice.

Area of knowledge: Social and Legal Sciences

Primary Education covers the mandatory educational period from 6 to 12 years of age.
