

Syllabus

Course: 26479-Communicative Competences I

Aims:

- (1) to explore the different types of research studies,
- (2) to learn how academic research is done (design of a study), and
- (3) to work on academic English.

You will develop the communicative competence regarding two aspects: on the one hand, you will work on academic English paying special attention to the writing style. On the other hand, you will learn how to design a research study to be conducted in the academic field, more specifically related to education.

All practical and theoretical content is related to teaching English or a Foreign Language in Pre-primary and Primary Education. The level of English required during the course is B2-C1 but at the end of the course you will be expected to have reached the C1 level (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)).

Evaluation: There is mid-term and end-term examinations and different tasks and assignments to complete during the course. You will be evaluated as an individual on your contributions to the class, through individual tasks and examinations.
