

**Summary line of work meeting 6 of the ToShare
Observatory on "Strengthening of the social protection
system and study of a BR (Universal and unconditional)"**

Held on 31 October, between 12:00 and 13:15 hours, in the Deanery (3rd floor) of the Faculty of Labour Relations and Social Work of the UPV/EHU and via skype.

The following is a list of the items on the agenda:

1. Information on the steps taken in the Observatory since the previous meeting held on 29 March 2019: contact with the 24 participating entities, keeping the website updated in Basque, Spanish and English, where many documents have been incorporated into the 6 lines of work, as well as disseminating various events. Four issues of the bulletin have also been published.

All attendees are very interested in the observatory. And it is valued in a very positive way that it is a meeting point to share our activities and reflections among people and entities.

Among the activities carried out by different members of the Commission there is talk of equality issues, specifically of a study that Oreka Sarea has carried out among the crews of Araba, and in the basic income of a forthcoming Popular Legislative Initiative to be presented in the Basque Parliament. Regarding the latter, it is reported that the

amount would not include the cost of housing, as it is understood that it is very diverse and complex and that it must be demanded to be a universal subjective right in accordance with the development of the 2015 Basque Law. It is also commented that the amount of this RB must be compatible with the receipt of a contributory pension.

2. It is agreed that these face-to-face meetings will be held every three months, and for the coming months there will be comments on continuing to share documents and publications. It is agreed that the Observatory should reflect the contributions of the different persons and entities, who are encouraged to take a more active role. There is also the possibility of generating debate on a topic on social networks, for example, accompanying the presentation of the ILP on an RB.
