

# RESOLUTION OF THE CALL FOR THE INTERNATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM OF THE TRANSOCEANIC CAMPUS (ITP-TOC 2026)

1. The ***International Training Program of the Transoceanic Campus (ITP-TOC 2026)*** aims to promote the transnational mobility of EHU (University of the Basque Country / Euskal Herriko Unibertsitatea) and BSU (Boise State University) students to carry out activities and projects by supporting **international internships with a predefined practical training plan**, aligned with the academic and professional profile of each participant.
2. The EHU published on april 13 2026 a Call for Applications to the International Training Program of the Transoceanic Campus (ITP-TOC 2026) to promote the international mobility of students enrolled at the BSU by supporting international internships in the Basque Country to carry out activities and projects.
3. The **Selection Committee** of the EHU has decided to grant the scholarships listed in Annex 1 of this resolution.
4. Selected candidates must formally accept the scholarship by signing the Acceptance Document (Annex 2) within 5 working days of notification. Failure to do so will be understood as a waiver.
5. Each internship, will be carried out in the company or host organization of the Basque Country mentioned in the annex 1, between 1 June 2026 and 31 July 2026.
6. During the internship, scholarship recipients will perform their duties in person, as required, and must be accompanied at all times by company staff and assigned mentor from its host university.
7. Each student receiving the grant must arrange their own travel to the internship location. The University of the Basque Country (EHU) will reimburse them for economy class travel expenses upon presentation of the corresponding invoice, up to a maximum of 1735€.
8. Student accommodation at the internship site will be provided directly by the EHU. Each student will be informed individually about their accommodation.

9. The EHU will pay each student 800€ per month to contribute to living expenses during the internship. This amount will be paid at the beginning of each month into the bank account number provided by the student.

10. The EHU will take out an insurance for each of the students for the entire duration of the scholarship.

11. Scholarship status may be lost due to:

- a) Voluntary resignation.
- b) Failure to comply with obligations set out in this Call.
- c) Early termination of the internship attributable to the beneficiary.
- d) Occurrence of any circumstance foreseen in applicable subsidy regulations.

In such cases, proportional reimbursement of funds may be required.
