

EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION FOR EMHE AND PREPARING FOR YOUR ENGLISH FRIENDLY COURSES (B2+)

Introduction: Who is the course for?

This course is designed for university lecturers and researchers wishing to improve their English-medium communication and teaching skills because they are participating in English Friendly Courses, Erasmus mobility programmes or are likely to be teaching their subject in English in the future.

The course is aimed at participants who have a B2+ level in English, and is **not** intended for teachers who have a C1 level or above.

Course Objective:

Participants will have the opportunity to improve their English medium communication and teaching skills by carrying out a variety of written and spoken tasks in and out of class.

Learning opportunities

- develop fluency and confidence in oral production and interaction when dealing with students and colleagues in English.
- manage English-medium tasks related to EFCs: class notes, tutorials, exams etc.
- develop an awareness of, and sensitivity towards, international academic and cultural diversity.
- view tools and resources for further professional development.

Course assessment:

To have successfully completed the course, participants will be required to:

- attend the course for at least 80% of the 15 hours in class.
- complete the set tasks.
- participate actively in class.

Course duration:

The course consists of 6 x 2.5 hour weekly sessions on Wednesdays (15 hours).
It will be offered online.
