

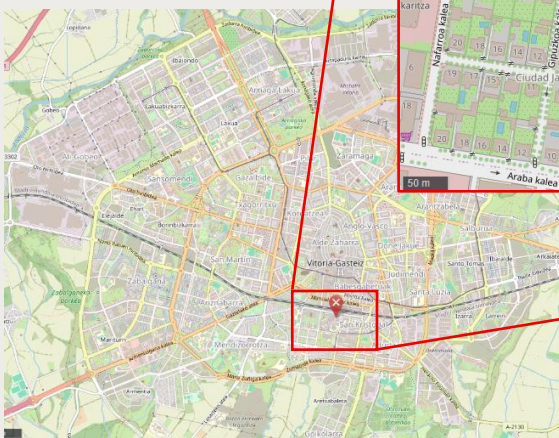
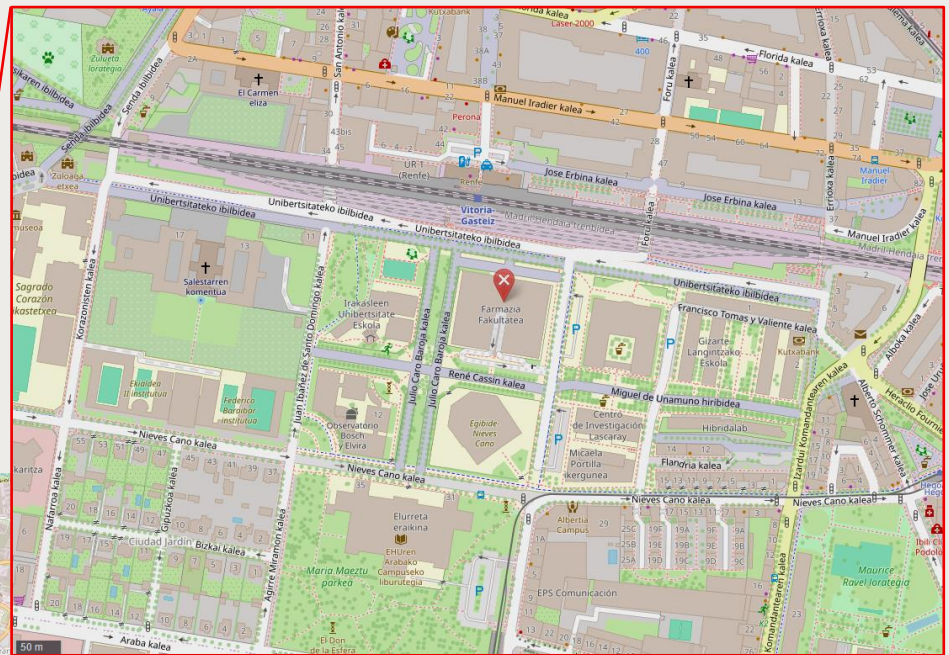


International Students Coming to the

General Information and Application Procedures

1. LOCATION

Our faculty is strategically located in the very center of the city of Vitoria-Gasteiz. See [link](#).

2. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

University of origin should make the nomination, and as soon as we make the registration, nominated students will receive an e-mail with the invitation to **register online**. In addition to the requirements of the application form online, the students must **send by e-mail the following documents in PDF** to the person in charge of the mobility at the Faculty of Pharmacy in UPV/EHU: nazioartekoak.farmazia@ehu.eus

1. Proof of the medical insurance for the period spent in the Basque Country (Spain). The UPV/EHU requests all international visitors on exchange programs to be covered by a Travel Assistance Insurance. This insurance **MUST** include the following **UNLIMITED** basic coverage:

- Transport and/or repatriation to home country in case of accident or illness of insured person
- Repatriation of the deceased insured

We recommend taking out civil liability insurance. UPV/EHU has an agreement with a specific company, and exchange students can also benefit from it.

2. Attestation of health insurance coverage filled and signed

3. European Health Insurance Card (for European citizens)

4. Copy of ID card or Passport

5. Passport-size photo

6. Certifying documentation that verifies the relationship with the Sending Institution.

7. Learning Agreement duly filled in and signed (Students from Erasmus program must sent it by EWP). In order to have detailed information about academic calendar and schedules, we advise students to consult our Faculty's site: [Faculty of Pharmacy - UPV/EHU](#)

Take into account that schedules are approved just before the summer holidays.

4. SCHEDULES

There are different teaching modalities, such as lectures, laboratory sessions and computer-based practicals, among others. In order to consult the schedule of each subject, you must first know the course and semester in which they are offered (see information [here](#)). In the [WEBUNTIS](#) application, select the degree and the course to view the weekly schedule. Please be aware that lectures can be taught in Spanish or Basque, and schedules could be different for each language. Masters' degree programmes publish their schedules on their [web pages](#).

5. DEADLINES

The **deadlines for submission of exchange student's applications and the aforementioned documents by e-mail** are:

- Full Academic year – July 1st
- 1st semester (autumn term) – July 1st
- 2nd semester (spring term) – December 15th

6. SPANISH AND BASQUE LANGUAGE COURSES

7. GRADING SYSTEM

Grade and Mark contain the result of the exam taken either on January (1st semester) or on June (2nd semester). In case there is no Mark and Grade says, "Not taken", that means that the student did not take the exam. There is an extraordinary exam for all the courses in June-July.

The number of credits for each subject is determined by the following criteria: One credit corresponds to ten hours of class attendance.
