Fall or Academic Year (August 25, 2025 – December 13, 2025): **March 14th, 2025**

Spring (January 5, 2026 – April 25, 2026): **September 15th, 2025**

*Students participating in Fall 2025/AY 25–26 are **REQUIRED** to arrive at FIU on **August 22, 2025**.*

*For Spring 2026, arrival is **REQUIRED** on **January 2, 2026**.*

NON-DEGREE SEEKING STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS

The Non-Degree Seeking Application is the form FIU uses to establish you as a student in the registration system and to generate a Panther ID number. As you complete your ISE application and supporting documents, please leave any spaces requiring your Panther ID blank. Once you receive your PID from the Registrar's Office via email, be sure to include this number as you continue to submit your required documents to our office.

You will need to register on the site in order to create your application, and this will allow you to save and go back to your application. **Read the instructions on their page carefully.**

- For **non US citizens**, please select "J-1" because you will study under a J-1 visa.
- Follow instructions for **International Address** – NO special characters
- No **social security number** unless you are a US citizen

- Make sure to mark **Visiting Student** for **Admit Type**
- Make sure to mark **International Student Exchange** for **Academic Plan**
